You'll get all this and more when you take the Mar Vista Historical Society's walking tour of Mormon Hill. Originally called Venice View Heights, it is the sixth oldest residential subdivision in Mar Vista.

Join us for a stroll through the past, learn about the impact this Mormon enclave had on the history of our community and of the many famous – and infamous – residents of this historic neighborhood.

The tour begins at 10 AM on the 1st Saturday of each month, on the north-side steps of the Mormon Church, on the southwest corner of Centinela and Windward Avenues (3655 S. Centinela). It covers a mile and a half, with an elevation gain of 200 feet, and lasts between 2 and 2 1/2 hours.
